THE QUESTION

"Shall the Two Rivers Public School District, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin be authorized to issue pursuant to Chapter 67 of the Wisconsin Statutes, general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$3,715,000 for the public purpose of paying the cost of a school improvement program at District buildings consisting of technology and security upgrades, plumbing, ceiling, flooring, roofing, asphalt and lighting improvements, and acquisition of related equipment?"



KOENIG ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

- 1931 Koenig Elementary School was built.
- 1991 Addition was put on Koenig including classrooms, offices, and library.
- 1998 Final addition was made to Koenig and the 1931 building was demolished.

MAGEE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

- 1960 Magee Elementary School was built.
- 1966 Addition was put on Magee including art, music and 4th grade classrooms.

L.B. CLARKE MIDDLE SCHOOL

- 1967 L.B. Clarke Middle School was built.
- 1991 Addition was put on L.B. Clarke including woodworking, art, and chorus rooms.
- 1998 Final addition was made to L.B. Clarke including additional classrooms.

TWO RIVERS HIGH SCHOOL

2002 - Two Rivers High School was built.



THE NEED & SOLUTION

Although our schools have been well maintained, both L.B. Clarke Middle School and Magee Elementary School are more than 50 years old. All schools are in need of some remodeling/ repairs. This referendum is an investment in maintaining our existing schools.



THE REFERENDUM - Not to exceed \$3,715,000

The Board of Education takes their responsibility very seriously to be efficient financial stewards of your tax dollars. The following chart summarizes the estimated tax impact:

- 2020 Two Rivers High School debt will be paid in full.
- 2021 The boilers at Magee Elementary School and L.B. Clarke Middle School will be paid in full.
- 2021 The first year of Referendum debt repayment.
- 2022 The second year of Referendum debt payment.
- 2023 The Referendum debt is paid in full.

Frequently Asked Questions:

What do asphalt repair and upgrades include?

- The Magee playground area has poor drainage that leads to ice build-up in winter. The north parking lot at Magee is beyond repair and needs to be replaced.
- L.B. Clarke has congestion problems with pick up and drop off due to a heavier volume of car traffic. Replacing the west asphalt parking lot will establish two safe locations to divide the L.B. Clarke population between the front and back of school.
- Two Rivers High School has selected areas of the lot that need to be milled, replaced, and patched.
- Koenig Elementary School requires repair of cracks and seals in selected areas.

Why do we need to replace the bathrooms?

- Bathrooms are original to the buildings, and the bathrooms at Magee and L.B. Clarke require plumbing beneath the concrete.
- One of L.B. Clarke's bathrooms is shut down due to a broken pipe in the floor.

Why are there ceiling replacement and upgrades?

• Ceiling tiles are original to the buildings at Magee and L.B. Clarke and are in need of replacement. The gym ceiling at L.B. Clarke is deteriorating and needs to be removed and replaced.

Why do we need a District storage building?

• We do not have storage in the district for materials.

Why do we need a District truck and snowplow?

• Our district is responsible for having our parking lots and drop off areas ready (and maintained) for school each day in winter. We currently have two trucks; however, one is 12 years old and needs to be replaced.

Where is the need for flooring?

• Magee and L.B. Clarke have flooring that is original to the buildings that need to be replaced for safety and maintenance.

Why install LED lighting?

• The cost, after incentives, will reduce the district's annual utility bill by approximately \$28,000. These lights will ultimately pay for themselves in 4 years.

What are our roofing needs?

- The 1991 addition at Koenig needs replacement.
- The entire roof at Magee, with the exception of the section that was replaced last year, needs to be replaced.
- The gym roof at L.B. Clarke needs to be recoated.

What are security upgrades?

• *A new, improved, and unified camera system will link to our police department for increased security.*

Why does L.B. Clarke need a stage curtain?

• The curtain is original and beyond repair.

What are the technology upgrades?

• Upgrade all computers and improve teaching tools with interactive boards for student learning.
