ARTICLE XII: ACTIVITIES

Section 1. The chapter shall be involved in at least two group service projects during the school year.

Section 2. Each member shall have the responsibility for choosing and participating in an individual service project(s) that reflects his or her particular talents and interests. This should consist of 15 hours of service.

Section 3. All members shall regularly participate in these projects. Failure to participate in service projects is a cause for dismissal.

Section 4. These projects shall have the following characteristics: fulfill a need within the school or community, have the support of the administration and the faculty, be appropriate and educationally defensible, and be well-planned, organized, and executed.

Section 5. Each marking quarter, members shall record the service on a verification sheet. Verification sheets must be turned in by the end of each marking quarter to the chapter adviser.

PLEASE NOTE: All National Junior Honor Society members will need to complete their individual service project(s) in order to comply with the Organization's Constitution. NJHS members will need to complete 15 hours. Service hours will be kept track of by the Advisors. Please submit the form found below for hours to be recorded. (New members are only required to complete seven hours their first year.)
