Literacy Goal: We, the Two Rivers Elementary Staff, will improve consistent delivery of our universal reading instruction by utilizing a balanced literacy approach and incorporating gradual release of responsibility in lesson planning and delivery so that 80% of K-4 students will meet or exceed expected growth or meet proficiency levels on end of year NWEA MAPS or benchmark assessments.

- ◇ Teachers will implement after school programs to supplement classroom instruction.
- ◇ Teachers will provide information for parents on their child's reading behaviors and comprehension.
- ◇ Teachers will hold a motivational Reading Week called "Having A Ball Reaching Our Goals!"
- ◇ Teachers will share the literacy proficiency of their students using NWEA-MAP (K-4) and classroom-based assessments (PreK-4).
- ◇ Parents will be informed of grade level reading expectations and the exit criteria at the beginning of the year "Open House" and parent/teacher conferences.
- ◇ Students will read 20 minutes after school hours.



School Engagement Goal: We, the Two Rivers Elementary Staff, will increase positive student school behaviors so that students are successful 80% of the year as measured by our monthly progress form.

- ◇ Daily student behavior form will be used to monitor student behaviors.
- ◇ We will continue to teach the monthly character education traits and enhance their meaning in the classroom.
- ◇ We will educate our school culture on bullying vs. conflict via social skills groups, guidance lessons, parent newsletters and school wide procedures (assemblies) to enhance positive student behaviors.
- ◇ We will continue to communicate behavior expectations with families on a frequent basis via daily behavior chart, weekly newsletters, phone calls and positive celebrations of above the line behaviors.
- ◇ We will continue to celebrate positive behavior with quarterly awards and monthly incentives.



Math Goal: We, the Two Rivers Elementary Staff, will improve consistent delivery of our universal math instruction by incorporating gradual release of responsibility so that 80% of K-4 students will meet or exceed expected growth or meet proficiency levels on end of year NWEA MAPS.

- ◇ Teachers will share the mathematical proficiency of their students using NWEA MAP (K-4) and classroom-based assessments (PreK-4).
- ◇ Teachers will create a math rich culture by providing opportunities for math fact assessments and showing evidence of math learning in every classroom.
- ◇ Every child will have access to math fact flashcards for home and will study them for a least 10 minutes nightly.
- ◇ Teachers will implement after school programs to supplement classroom instruction.
- ◇ Parents will be informed of grade level math expectations and the exit criteria at our beginning of the year "Open House" and parent/teacher conferences.
- ◇ Students will do 10 minutes of math facts after school hours.
