I worked third shift for the first 10, years then moved to first shift and became a School Resource Officer (SRO) for LBC in 2006. I have many duties with the Two Rivers Police Department. I am a Vehicle Contacts Instructor, Defense and Arrest Tactics Instructor, Evidence Technician, Field Training Officer, a Liaison for the Crossing Guards, NARC II Drug Testing Instructor, Bike Patrol Trainer, D.A.R.E. Instructor, ALICE Trainer, WDOA Treasurer and SRO. Becoming a Police Officer was something I always wanted to do growing up, following in my uncle and dad's footsteps. Working with the middle school kids and their families allows me to become a role model and build a more positive image of police.

All of our staff and students have been trained in ALICE and I am trained trainer in ALICE. ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate) is an acronym for response options that allow the person to make informed decisions during a crisis. I also take reports, answer questions, follow up for other officers, conduct investigations, mediate problems and issue citations. I am an Advisor to 12- 7th grade students giving them support throughout the school year. As a member of the 7th grade team I also teach an enrichment during S.M.A.S.H. (Student Motivated Academic Success Hour). I teach D.A.R.E. to 5th and 7th grade students at LBC and St. Peter the Fisherman School. I also give various presentations throughout out the year to classes and other organizations. I have a CSI class that I teach after school to LBC students. This class started at Koenig to 3rd and 4th grade. I also coach boys basketball at LBC.

I am originally from Washburn, a small city in Northern Wisconsin. I attended the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh and received a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice. I am married to Sandy Greene and we have a son Cameron Greene who is a sophomore in college.
