## 5461 - HIGH SCHOOL GRADING POLICY

Students will be awarded grades in the following manner:

- A 90-100%
- B 80-89%
- C 70-79%
- D 60-69%
- F 60% or lower

Each student's grade point average is calculated quarterly and for the semester. Averages are calculated using the following scale:

- A 4.0 B 3.0 C 2.0
- D 1.0
- E 0.0 The student receives credit for the course; however, the GPA is negatively affected by the 0 points earned. This grade may be given at the discretion of the teacher when the student exhibits regular attendance and effort but lacks the ability to receive a passing grade.
- F 0.0 The student does not receive credit, and the GPA is negatively affected by 0 points earned.
- P 0.0 The student receives credit for the course, and then grade does not affect the GPA.

## 11/2/2018

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Students completing approved alternative or virtual school classes will have those grades calculated into GPA and class standing as any other course in the high school.

Students who study abroad will be awarded 6 credits (elective) for the completion of a school year experience. Credits will be prorated should their experience be shorter. No GPA calculation will be made for these elective classes.

Students who transfer to Two Rivers High School from a home-school setting will be granted credit for those classes that are indicated on an "official" transcript.
