Tips to inspire your child at home:

- Read with your child every day, even if it's only for a few minutes.
(As you are reading point to pictures and label them and encourage your child to do so also.)
- Talk with your child throughout the day about what you are doing and things that are happening around you.
- Talk about feelings with your child.
 - Be consistent with rules.
- Try to limit screen time to an hour a day and encourage active play.
(No app without a lap)
- Encourage independence with simple tasks.
(allow your child to help with cooking: mixing, washing fruits and vegetables, doing the dishes, etc...)
- Love, praise, and encourage your child at all times!
- Enjoy your child, laugh with them often and have fun with them!

Early Childhood Special Education

The Early Childhood Classroom actively engages children so they develop the pre-academic skills for future success by enhancing their strengths and supporting their needs. Early Childhood Special Education is available to children from birth through age 5 with disabilities or developmental delays. A team consisting of a school psychologist, teacher, therapists and parents will determine if a child is eligible and in need of an Individualized Education Plan (IEP).
