We are pleased to inform you that **Two Rivers Public Schools** will be implementing the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) while participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs for School Year **2023-2024**.

What does this mean for you and your children attending the school(s) identified below?

Great news! All enrolled students of **Two Rivers Public School District** are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at **no charge** to your household each day of the school year. Your child (ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or submit a meal application.

The district will still be requesting applications from households with a student participating in the CEP; however, receipt of free breakfast and lunch meals does not depend on returning it. Completing the application is still necessary for other programs **program(s) like waivers and grants that would help out all departments within our district and may be used to determine if your household is eligible for these additional benefits.*

The letter must contain the complainant's name, address, telephone number, and a written description of the alleged discriminatory action in sufficient detail to inform the Assistant Secretary for Civil Rights (ASCR) about the nature and date of an alleged civil rights violation.
