Special Board Minutes, Apr 2, 2025

### 1. OPENING

- A. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by President Henrickson.
- B. Present: Wendy Brandt, Jennifer Henrickson, Tim Klinkner, Zak Peterson, Gary Shavlik, Randy Williams, Lori Zimney.
- C. Written notice of this meeting was sent to the news media on Wednesday, March 26, 2025.
- D. Motion by Shavlik, second by Klinkner to approve the agenda; motion carried 7-0.

2. Motion by Williams, second by Klinkner to adjourn to Closed Session under State Statute 19.85 (1)(c)(f) for the purpose of discussion: Considering compensation of any public employee over which the government body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility, and Considering financial or personal histories of specific persons at 7:01 pm; motion carried 7-0 on a roll call vote.

3. Motion by Williams, second by Klinkner to convene into Regular Session for the purpose of considering motions as a result of Closed Session at 8:25 pm; motion carried 7-0 on a roll call vote. Motion by Klinkner, second by Williams to accept the resignation of Hallie Steinberg, Program Support, effective the end of the 2024-2025 school year; motion carried 7-0. Motion by Williams, second by Brandt to terminate an employee contract as discussed in closed session, effective June 30, 2025; motion carried 7-0 on a roll call vote. Motion by Klinkner, second by Williams to approve Teacher Contracts with a \$631 pay increase per cell and a step increase for a total salary increase of 3.06% for the 2025-2026 school year; motion carried 7-0 on a roll call vote. Motion by Klinkner, second by Williams to approve a 3% pay increase for support staff for the 2025-2026 school year; motion carried 7-0 on a roll call vote. Motion by Klinkner, second by Williams to approve a 3% pay increase for the administrative team for the 2025-2026 school year; motion carried 7-0 on a roll call vote. Motion by Klinkner, second by Williams to approve a 3% pay increase on the co-curricular list of agreements for the 2025-2026 school year; motion carried 7-0 on a roll call vote. Motion by Klinkner, second by Williams to approve a 3% pay increase for substitute teachers for the 2025-2026 school year; motion carried 7-0 on a roll call vote.

4. Motion by Klinkner, second by Shavlik to adjourn the meeting at 8:33 pm; motion carried.
