PRIOR APPROVAL OF COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS REQUIRED

(Twenty hours of community service are required for graduation.)

Volunteer at area nursing homes
Volunteer at the Hamilton Care Center in Two Rivers

Volunteer at the Hamilton Wood Type
Museum in Two Rivers

Volunteer at recycling center
Volunteer at Lester Public Library
Highway clean-up/Adopt-a-Highway
Raking leaves/shoveling snow for the elderly/disabled
Volunteer at Special Olympics

Coach/assist with youth sports program/volunteer referee, umpire, scorekeeper, concessions
Coach cheerleading for younger students

Tutoring
Assist in community food pantry (TREP)

Volunteer at Humane Society

Volunteer at local hospital

Church/parish volunteer – serve, lector, cantor, church and school cleaning

Assist/teach Bible or religious education classes

Assist with parish picnics/festivals

Youth representative for parish councils

Volunteer for Red Ribbon Week (AODA awareness)

Assist or be an aide for Girl Scouts/Boy Scouts

Be a teacher's aide/volunteer at school district's summer school program

Babysitting services during Parent/Teacher conferences

D.A.R.E. volunteer

Volunteer for Police Department projects

Salvation Army bell ringer

- These are just examples – there may be other service activities that are appropriate. See a counselor if you have any questions.
- Community service is intended to be service out in the larger community. Therefore, helping out family members or someone who owns a private business is not considered a community service activity. Helping out a non-profit organization is acceptable.
- If you do volunteer work in the schools, only one-half of the hours (ten hours) can be used to meet your community service requirement.
