Committee of the Whole Board Meeting - October 28, 2019

- 1. The meeting was called to order by Vice President Maria Veldre at 6:30 p.m.
- 2. The following members were present: Commissioners Jennifer Henrickson, Zak Peterson, Gregory Ross, Julie Schroeder, and Maria Veldre. Commissioners Randy Williams and Jaimie Salta were excused.
- 3. Written notice of this meeting was sent to the news media on Friday, October 25, 2019.
- 4. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- 5. Motion by Com. Ross, seconded by Com. Peterson, to approve the agenda as posted; motion carried unanimously.
- 6. Recognition of invited visitors and guests: L.B. Clarke students who are taking Geometry at TRHS talked about what their schedules look like. They start their day at TRHS until 9:00 a.m. and miss the AA/WIN time at L.B. Clarke. They are then able to take an additional class at L.B. Clarke for high school credit. Student Council representatives also provided an update on activities at school including Activity Night for Halloween and a Dodgeball tournament.

 - A. Motion by Com. Ross, seconded by Com. Peterson to Certify the Tax Levy in the amount of \$5,666,081 with a Mill Rate of \$9.57 per thousand of equalized value and a 3.23% tax levy increase over prior year; motion carried unanimously.
- 9. District Administrator's Report:
 - A. Austin Schroeger provided an update on the E-Sport TR Raiders team that is 5-0. For esport, there are 10 players with five starters and five alternates. They are playing Smash Brothers on Nintendo Switch and the season runs for 8 weeks. Chad Bauknecht reported that on Wednesday a representative from CESA 7 will be working with Kindergarten and First grade on Phonics. Wednesday is also Spooky Story Night from 6:00 – 7:00 p.m. at both Koenig and Magee. Thursday is Orange and Black Day. On November 11th there will be a Veterans Day presentation at 8:45 a.m. at Magee and at 10:00 a.m. at Koenig. Tim Wester reported that on October 17th the entire LBC student body came to TRHS to see the musical The Addams Family. He thanked all who worked on the show – it was amazing! He also reported that Claire Wick is working with teachers on professional development and then visits the classrooms with feedback. He reported that Tuesday is Pink Out day, Thursday is Orange, Black, and Purple Day and Friday there is an Activity Night. Cross Country sectionals qualified three athletes from Two Rivers for State competition: Anna Gallagher, Mickey Helling, and Mackenzie Greenwood. On November 7th L.B. Clarke and TRHS will have a combined Veterans Day presentation at TRHS. District-wide Parent-Teacher conferences will be held the week of November 11th. There will be a TREP Food Drive on November 2nd sponsored by the Two Rivers Public School District. Coming events were announced.
