A. Updates:

Dana McLinn shared an informational slideshow of the AGR Grant work done by Koenig Elementary teachers over the last few years. The grant ends on June 30, 2021 and they have reapplied for the 2021-2022 school year. Focus has been on 3 strategies: class size reduction, professional practice in ELA and Math, and reaching everyone by creating agendas with action plans and looking at the progress of all students. Everyone was grateful for the good weather, amazing graduates, the great turnout from staff and family members, and the great efforts of the facilities and grounds crew.
