


TWO RIVERS PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT

Committee of the Whole Board Meeting – March 22, 2021

1. The meeting was called to order by President Jaimie Salta at 6:38 p.m.

5. Motion by Com. Veldre, seconded by Com. Ross, to approve the agenda as posted; motion carried unanimously.
6. Recognition of invited visitors and guests: None.
7. Questions and comments from citizens on agenda items:

We have close to twenty partnerships, and it is growing. The Forward testing window is open at Koenig, Magee and L.B. Clarke. Parent-teacher conferences will be pushed back due to testing.
