- 14. District Administrator's Report:
  - SRO Monty Greene provided an update on safety in schools and what we do to protect our students and staff. ALICE training, provided to all students and staff, is used in response to an intruder in the building. Lisa Quistorf was at Koenig Elementary School earlier today and the kindergarten class was talking about safety and Yell and Tell was being taught. Lisa thanked the Board for supporting our SRO's in each of the buildings. Dana McLinn provided a report on Achievement Gap Reduction (AGR) formerly known as SAGE or Student Achievement Guarantee in Education. Dana reported that our district uses the funds for class size reduction (up to 18 students). She also provided information on the School's Performance Objectives in Math, Literacy, and Engagement. She reported on how student's needs and growth are measured by NWEA Maps Assessments in Reading and Math, and Benchmark Reading Assessments, done 3 times a year; one-on-one CAFÉ instructional times, End of Unit Summative Math Assessments, observation and feedback from students; and the statewide Forward Assessment. Chad Bauknecht reported than he and Dana will be presenting to the Rotary Club at 7:00 tomorrow morning. Forward testing will begin the week of April 9<sup>th</sup>. Building principals provided an update on events taking place in their buildings. The Two Rivers High School Robotics Team was invited to the 1<sup>st</sup> World Championship. The team received the Engineering Inspiration Award.
