

# MackinVIA eBooks and Audiobooks

L.B. Clarke LMC's eBooks and audiobooks collection can be accessed through the L.B. Clarke LMC Alexandria Online Catalog or directly through MackinVIA. Go to the LMC's website at [www.trschools.k12.wi.us/faculty/DCOLLINS/lbclarkelmc.cfm](http://www.trschools.k12.wi.us/faculty/DCOLLINS/lbclarkelmc.cfm) and click on the Alexandria Online Catalog link or click on the MackinVIA link to access the eBooks. You will need to type in L B Clarke and then click on the school's name for MackinVIA.

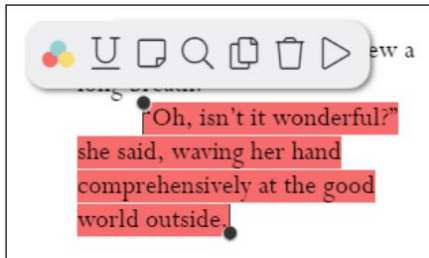
Access your notebook, view book info and table of contents, search inside the book, cite it, or close the book and return to MackinVIA

## Highlight and Notes Toolbar and Buttons

Select the text by clicking and dragging the cursor. Click on the highlighted text to bring up the toolbar.



Highlight Color Button: Highlight the selected text.

Select the text by clicking and dragging the cursor or Text Selection Pins (or tap/hold on a mobile device). Click on the highlighted text to bring up the Options menu. When the menu appears, select the **Highlight Color** button or **Underline** button.



Underline Button: Underline the selected text.



Note Button: Add a note to the selected text.



A Note icon appears in the margins when a note is associated with the highlighted passage



Find more instances of the selected term inside the ebook



Delete button: cancels the selection of the passage



Copy text



Text to speech



Text Selection Pins, which allow for expanding or shrinking the selected passage

## Dictionary



Click on a word to activate the dictionary and then click on the dictionary icon.
