
## Kingdom Fungi

## A. Characteristics of Fungi

- 1. Are eukaryotic, mostly saprobic (absorb organic molecules from dead material) organisms.
- 2. Are parasitic, symbiotic, or freeliving.
- 3. Are ecologically important as decomposers and recyclers.
- 4. Reproduce asexually and sexually and disperse to new habitats by means of spores.
- 5. Each cell is enclosed in a rigid cell wall composed of chitin.

## **B.** Body Plan

- 1. Body plan is adapted to fungus' saprobic method for acquiring nutrients.
- 2. A spore germinates into a threadlike hypha which grows rapidly and branches to form a mycelium. (mat)
- 3. rhizoids hyphae that penetrates material. Release enzymes that digest.



## C. In Humans,

- 1. Some live on skin, vagina, or gastrointestinal tract in harmony with normal bacterial flora
- 2. Most have limited ability to cause disease.
- 3. Causes of disease
  - a. Disturbance of natural flora
  - b. Impaired immune system
